Dear Pastor Schleicher:

Thank you for your letter of October 20th which is now before me. I am very sorry that the heading of the article to which you refer in the August-September issue of our official publication has you somewhat puzzled and is in need of clarification. The heading merely, in plain words, states what the article describes. Pastor Krueger, a Missouri Synod pastor, is, by virtue of his education, well aware of what the Holy Scriptures teach concerning unionism, the doctrine of the divine call, and the mixture of church and state. You, too, have learned these Scriptural teachings at Concordia Theological Seminary, Springfield, Ill., and are capable of refreshing your mind concerning them. You should then be able to answer the question as to whether Pastor Krueger feared God or man by his vacillating position — first by consenting to offer the prayers at the Commencement exercises and by, later, under pressure, withdrawing.

I hope this answers your question to your satisfaction and enlightenment.
